

Counselling and Intervention Centre

Domestic violence is the most widespread form of violence against women in our society. It includes physical, psychological and sexual violence.

Violence often doesn't begin with beating, but rather with humiliation, insults, control and/or social isolation. Those affected are often uncertain and only much later realise that something has gone wrong in their relationship.

No woman has to simply accept and endure violence. Through the Protection Against Violence Act (went into force in 2002), domestic violence is no longer a private matter.

We provide advice to women from the district of Main-Taunus in conflict or emergency situations.

Personal counselling is available once an appointment is made by telephone. All conversations are confidential and open-ended. Counselling is free of charge and can be anonymous upon request.

Women's Shelter Main-Taunus-Kreis

Women's shelters are especially secure places of protection and refuge; their addresses cannot be found in the directory. All women who experience physical, sexual or psychological violence can find safety and support here, with or without their children – regardless of where they come from, what their legal residence status is or whether they can provide for themselves financially.

Women and children who have taken refuge in the Women's Shelter receive information and support for securing their livelihoods, on questions about child custody and visitation rights and on separation and divorce.

However, the Women's Shelter is not a home. Those living here are responsible for their own everyday organisation and for raising their children.

Children are always also victims of domestic violence. We offer pedagogical services for individuals and groups. Our staff members also provide support for registering and deregistering at kindergartens and schools.

Women who are looking for a place at the Women's Shelter are welcome to receive counselling over the telephone in advance. They can find out which documents and personal items they should bring with them, if possible.
